- The course is challenging especially if you miss classes and labs But TAs and the professors have lots of office hours available if you need help you can just drop by The weakness of the course I could say is that most of the homeworks dont really help prepare for the exam I wish the home actually had the kinds of questions that might be on exams That would have been very useful

- Strength Very clear in his explanationsWeakness Doesn't make the class very engaging
- Strengths-I feel like Professor Roulston was a strong instructor in the way he was willing to explain any topics that people were confused about He also was very nice and willing to help in office hours if needed Weaknesses-There were a few times during class where Professor Roulston went a little too quickly with his work and just showed his answer without showing how he got it which caused confusion
- Teaching pace sometimes felt as if it spent more time explaining simpler concepts than the challenging ones This could be in part due to a lack of communication from students Overall concepts and examples were well explained during lecture and fairly easy to follow I appreciated the effort made to include students in a variety of ways in lectures and labs encourage feedback and questions and keep flipped classroom videos concise
- The instructor did a good job at covering all the material and providing example problems to apply what we learned The instructor did drag on with certain problems we were doing which made the lectures as a whole feel slow and repetitive

- when doing example problems having a more structural and organized approach visually might help students follow along better and organize the information in their heads- it felt like the last part of the puzzle piece was missing when we went over problems step by step and then skipped over the algebra not talking about when we would plug values into equations but more so when we would manipulate equations even though time is limited in lectures it might help students really solidify what they're learning if that extra step was taken

- If the material in the flipped classroom videos is repeated during lecture there is no real reason to require the videos It was remarked by the professor that the readings were important because they covered material we were unable to in lecture time but would it be possible to include more of the information in flipped classroom videos then Additionally I believe there are websites similar to Point Solutions that do not require students to pay for a subscription If the lectures continue to be recorded on Zoom I believe there is a similar function on there that could serve as a possible alternative
